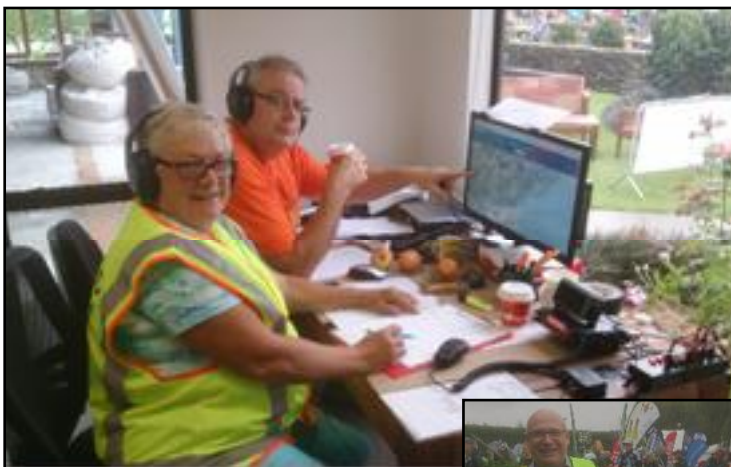

Reports:

General Business:

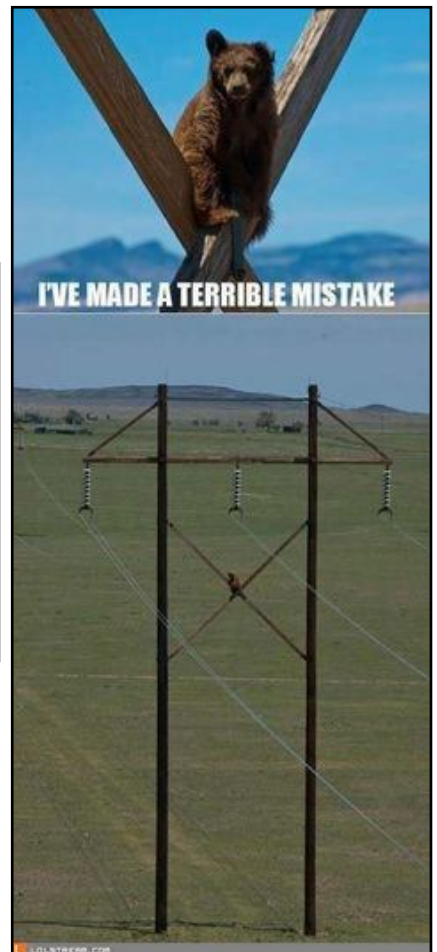
Rob thanked those who had helped with the Car Club Sprint
